Garett Lee Sidor, a student at Windsor Park Collegiate was an outstanding student athlete. His life tragically ended on May 17, 2007. Garett participated in many sports, including hockey, volleyball and basketball. He was selected as an All-Star in the 2007 Provincial "AAA" Basketball Championships which his Windsor Park Royals captured. He was also named to the All Manitoba Team.

Garett's friends and family have set aside two scholarships to be awarded to a female and male high school basketball player who displays sportsmanship, leadership, and outstanding ability. Two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each will be awarded annually to a male and female player.

Nominations will be taken in by Manitoba Highs Schools Athletic Association and scholarship funds will be administered through the Garett Lee Sidor Scholarship Fund at the Winnipeg Foundation. Contributions to this fund may be made by contacting the Winnipeg Foundation.
