Boston Pizza AAAA Provincial Volleyball Championships Final Four Set

The 2019 Boston Pizza AAAA Provincial Volleyball Championships is down to the final four. A total of 12 boys teams and 12 girls teams began regional playoffs on November 22 and 23. Four boys teams and four girls teams have advanced to semi-final action at the University of Manitoba's Investors Group Athletic Centre later this week.

The Girls semi-finals take place on Wednesday, November 27 at 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

The Boys semi-finals take place on Thursday, November 28 at 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

The Championship finals are on Monday, December 2 at the Investors Group Athletic Centre, beginning with the Girls final at 6:00 p.m. followed by the Boys match at 8:00 p.m. Both matches will be live streamed at mhsaa.ca starting at 6:00 p.m.

On the girl's side, the top seeded Dakota Lancers are pitted against 5th seeded Oak Park Raiders and 3rd seed Vincent Massey Vikings (Brandon) are up against the 2nd seed Portage Saints.

In boy's action, 1st seed Steinbach Regional Sabres will face the 4th seed Dakota Lancers and the 3rd seed Westwood Warriors will play the 2nd seed St. Paul's Crusaders.

The Provincial A, AA and AAA Championships are also taking place from November 28 – November 30 throughout Manitoba with 60 teams seeking six Provincial Championship titles.


