Elam Target Scoring Rules:

1. The first time the game clock stops with 4:00 minutes or less in the 4th Quarter of each game, time played will end and a TARGET SCORE will be set, EQUAL to the LEADING Teams Score plus nine(9).

EXAMPLE: At the less than 4:00min., at the stoppage, IF the score is 77 – 71, then the TARGET SCORE after adding 9 points to the Leading score(77) becomes 86. *FIRST TEAM TO SCORE 86 WINS THE GAME*

- 2. If the stoppage at/under 4:00min. is a foul shot resulting in free throws, the free throw(s) will be administered before setting the Target Score.
- 3. The Shot Clock will remain intact and used for the ENTIRE DURATION of the 4th quarter of the game as it normally would be.
- 4. ONLY TWO(2) Time Outs may be used by each team during the untimed portion of the 4th quarter. If you have 3 time-outs left under 4min stoppage, you will lose a time-out
- 5. THE FIRST TEAM TO REACH THE TARGET SCORE WINS THE GAME.
