

2022 Credit Union Scholar Athlete

Each school in the province is invited to select their own outstanding male and female scholar athlete (**one male and one female per school**). The nominees from each school will receive recognition certificates. All nominations will be considered for the provincial awards. Each of the four recipients will receive a \$1,000.00 bursary courtesy of Manitoba's Credit Unions, and an attractive plaque. The awards will be presented in June 2022.

Eligibility:

Participated in a minimum of two (2) interscholastic MHSAA recognized athletic programs within one school year.

Minimum average of eighty-five percent (85%) (**2021-2022 school year**).

Must be taking a full course load, with at least two (2) 40S level courses.

Grade 12 students only (second year grad 12 not eligible).

Athletics, academics and citizenship taken into consideration.

Students must be attending a Canadian University or College.

Criteria:

Academic Achievement: honour roll, scholarship and average.

Citizenship - participation in other activities (community, church, etc.)

Athletic Participation (only MHSAA school sports considered) - number of MHSAA activities participated in, contribution to team or individual activity, awards/recognition.

Personal Athletic Achievement - records, all-star/MVP, ranking's, member of championship team.

Other School Activities - Student council, grad-committee, yearbook, choir, drama, band, other.
